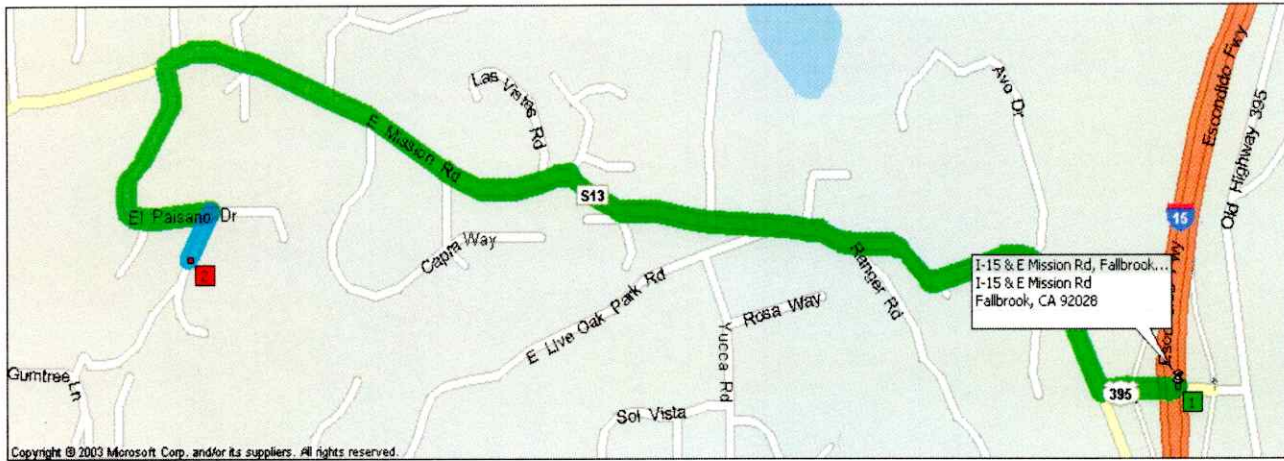

Exit I-15 at Mission Rd., Fallbrook

1. Turn right from I-15 southbound ...
